"She Knows Where She is Going" award; the Silver Star Achievers Award; Ruby R. Wharton Outstanding Women Awards for Public Awareness; the April 4th Foundation's H. Ralph Jackson Trailblazer Award; 2015 "Keepers of the Dream Award," "2015 Kindle Award" and, the NBA Grizzlies' Community Heroes Award. I have also received numerous Professional Awards related to her work.
	In addition to my professional and civic affiliations, I am heavily involved with the Democratic Party on the local, state and national level. As the Secretary of the Tennessee Democratic Party, I am the first African-American elected as a Constitutional officer -a position I have held since 1997.
	In 2001, I was elected as the Chair of the Shelby County Democratic Party I was the first female to run for that position and the first female to Chair the local Party. Prior to being the Chair of the Shelby County Democratic Party, I served as the First Vice Chair of the Shelby County Democratic Executive Committee from 1994 to 1997. I founded the Shelby County Democratic Party's major fundraiser – the John F. Kennedy Day Dinner in 1996 and it continues today as its primary fundraiser.

Additionally, I was elected to serve as a delegate for the Democratic National Convention in 1996, 2000, 2004, 2008, 2012 and 2016.
